





Different Hull Types Explained

Hull Shape	Hull Design & Type	Description
	FLAT-BOTTOMED HULLS Used on tug boats, rowboats, and skiffs	Stable but not recommended for bluewater
	V-SHAPED HULLS Used on powerboats	Requires power but can handle waves
	ROUND-BOTTOMED HULLS Usually seen on canoes	Can handle rough water and extreme hull speed
	PONTOON HULLS Used on Pontoon boats	Very stable but not recommended for bluewater
	MULTIHULLS Used on catamarans and sailboats	Can handle rough water, has a stable and faster performance
